

Water Ski & Wakeboard Alberta Ranking Lists for Virtual Slalom Scores with World Waterski League

How the Ranking List Works:

Ranking list placing's are based on a six (6) score average.

For Athlete's that have less than six scores they will be a penalty of one (1) buoy for every pass less than the six minimums. Ex. Score 1 is 2@35 score 2 is 1 @ 35 the average is 1.5 @ 35 less penalty of 4 buoys due to less than six scores entered, therefore ranking list score would be 3.5 @ 35.

When an athlete's average of their top six (6) scores bumps them into the next division they will be automatically moved up into that division.

An athlete can choose any of the three speed divisions to compete under regardless of age, sex or ability however it must be stipulated in the application at the beginning of the year.

An athlete can change speed divisions (submitted in writing to Jay Kolewaski) but cannot hold scores in more than one speed division.

If an athlete changes a division, no scores can be transferred to the new division, they must be earned to be registered.

NO RERIDES for any video submissions, any tampering with video to create a 'tournament set' will result in immediate removal and lifetime ban from participation. No inquiry, no jury, no second chances.
